Dewan Filharmonik PETRONAS (DFP) is Malaysia's first concert hall dedicated to classical music and home to the Malaysian Philharmonic Orchestra (MPO). Located at the PETRONAS Twin Towers, it was officially opened on 17 August 1998 by the Patron of the MPO, YABhg. Tun Dr. Siti Hasmah Haji Mohd Ali and Prime Minister, Tun Dr. Mahathir Mohamad.

Designed by Cesar Pelli, the hall takes its inspiration from the traditional shoe-box shape of the great 19th century European concert halls with the magnificent Klais Pipe Organ providing a spectacular backdrop to the stage.

The hall seats 920 people at one time which includes box seats, corporate suites and a royal suite. Acoustics experts Kirkegaard & Associates have incorporated unique acoustical devices into its design to maximize the hall's natural qualities.

DFP plays an integral part in the music and cultural landscape of the city of Kuala Lumpur and Malaysia. It continues to enthral audiences since the day it first opened its doors. Among renowned Malaysian artists who have mesmerized audiences at DFP include Tan Sri SM Salim, Dato' Sheila Majid, Dato' M Nasir, Dato' Siti Nurhaliza, Dato' Hattan, Datuk Jamal Abdillah, Datuk Khadijah Ibrahim, Datuk

Ramli Sarip, Datuk Aishah, Ella, Yuna, Faizal Tahir, Dayang Nurfaizah, Aubrey Suwito, Akim, Hazama, Hujan, Misha Omar and many more.

International superstars who have graced the stage are Harry Connick Jr., Diana Krall, Anoushka Shankar, Laura Fygi, Zakir Hussain, Larry Carlton, Harvey Malaihollo, Ruth Sahanaya, and Judika.

World renowned orchestras that have performed here include the New York Philharmonic, Philadelphia Orchestra, BBC Symphony, and Vienna Symphony.

Beyond classical music, DFP has hosted ensembles of jazz and world music genres such as the Count Basie Orchestra, Yellowjackets, Ladysmith Black Mambazo, Mezzoforte, Igudesman & Joo, Pink Martini, and Gotan Project.

DFP has also been the venue for many local and international cultural performances, corporate events and film recording. Some of the clients that DFP have worked with are UMW Toyota, Embassy of The Republic of Korea, Embassy of Japan, Allianz Malaysia, SP Setia, PETRONAS, MCKK Foundation, Universiti Teknologi PETRONAS (UTP) and The Japan Foundation, Kuala Lumpur.

DFP's success is attributed to its exceptional architectural design, superior acoustics, and recording studio modelled after the legendary Abbey Road Studios. As the first purpose-built concert hall in Malaysia, DFP will continue to become the premier iconic hall with diverse music and cultural offerings to create unique experience for all.

Established in 1998, Ruffedge is a group known for its R&B and hip-hop genres. The group's name was inspired by two international hip-hop and R&B legends, Ruff Ryders and Jagged Edge. In its early years, the group was known as Vibe.

The group was founded by three of its earliest members: Cat Farish, Zain Hamid and Azim. Azan Addin joined in 1998. The group's debut was on Sony Battery Face On Talent Search Competition in 1999, which they won. Later, Azim parted ways and was replaced by Mode.

The group's singles such as *Tipah Tertipu* and *Da Bomb* became a sensation among the fans. It also offers a softer song, *Bila Rindu*, for the melancholics. The group collaborated with V.E. to revive the song *Khayalan* (originally performed by Black Dog Bone).

Ruffedge has released three studio albums and two compilation albums throughout its career. Through its debut album, *Extreme Pleasure*, Ruffedge won the Artis Harapan award at the Anugerah Industri Muzik (AIM) in 2003. The subsequent album, *Defined* (2004), became a huge success with over 40,000 units sold, receiving platinum awards. The album was also nominated for Best Pop Album at AIM 2005. Its following album *Ruffera* also received a platinum award.

In 2004, Ruffedge appeared as a cameo in teenage musical *SH3 The Movie* and starred in the film *Tipah Tertipu The Movie*.

In 2006, Cat left the group, followed by Amer Munawer and Sein in 2007.

Iwan and Nine later joined the group. The changing of group members was to ensure that the band lives on. The real challenge for Ruffedge was maintaining a spot in the local music industry with the rise of local indie bands, the withering influence of R&B and the competition from Indonesian bands.

Ruffedge was disbanded in 2008. The members parted ways while keeping a close knit of their brotherhood. Azan and Amer performed spiritual songs through a group, Al-Mawlid. Sein and Zain continued with their acting career and behind-the-scene work in the film industry. Cat pursued his interest in songwriting, producing albums for other artists and founded The Fabulous Cats.

Ruffedge made a comeback in the music industry on 18 March 2018 at Movie Animation Park Studio (MAPS), Ipoh, in conjunction with the anniversary of BoboiBoy's animated series.

That year marked the group's 20th year in the industry. It was celebrated on 4 August 2018 with a concert themed 'Ruffedge: 20th Anniversary' at KL Live. The concert was meant for all the fans that supported the group for 20 years. Ruffedge also released a new single, *Seperti Mereka*, which was added into its repertoire.

After the resounding success of its comeback, the group continued its journey with a concert in Singapore. It was its first concert for their fans in the Lion City.

Ruffedge has garnered a huge amount of viewers over the years. Its performance at Anugerah Meletop Era in 2018 received over 3 million views on Youtube.


